From the Desk of Father John

The Center for Applied Research in the Apostolate (CARA) at Georgetown University tells us that the percentage of Americans who call themselves Catholic – roughly a quarter of the United States population – has remained relatively steady over the last 50 years. About 72% of people who grew up Catholic remain Catholic as adults, according to CARA. The following are some of CARA’s statistics:

- Number of Catholics in 1965..... 45.6 million
- Number of Catholics in 2007..... 64.4 million
- Percentage of Americans raised Catholic, but no longer Catholic.... 8.1%
- Percentage of Latinos identifying as Catholic 64%
- Number of new Catholics in 2007 (includes Baptism of adults and infants; people received into full communion)..... 1.1 million

If you have a family member or friend who has left the Church, you may want to pray this prayer:

Lord, I want (Name) to know and love You as I do. I worry, Lord, what paths (Name) may take without the wisdom of Your Church to guide the way.

#### Cycles of Faith – 21st Sunday in Ordinary Time

Within the private chapel of the Pope at the Vatican, an icon referred to as the Mandylion of Edessa sits behind a gold frame. It purports to show the face of Christ on a cloth; legend has it that Jesus Himself sent it to King Abgar of Edessa, having pressed His face into it to create the image. Like the Shroud of Turin, people look at this icon and wonder if it is truly an image of the Son of God.

How do you recognize Jesus? Jesus asks His disciples who the people think that He is; remember that the people had been awaiting a kingly savior, so this very common, ordinary man was thought to be Elijah, Jeremiah or one of the prophets. They had not seen Him or met Him, and even then might not have been convinced. But Peter, speaking from the heart, recognized Him as "the Christ, the Son of the living God."



The physical characteristics of the Son of Man should have little or no matter in our lives today; what is important is to remember that we are taught that Jesus Christ is the light of all humanity, a light that shines so brightly for all the world to see that we have no trouble distinguishing it as anything else (CCC 748). Like Peter, look to your heart for the loving light, and boldly share it with the world to the best of your abilities.
