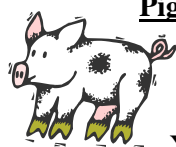
May 23: *Friday Night Fiesta* from 9:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. at the Youth House. All High School Youth are invited to attend.
