## From the Desk of Father John

We are in the process of renovating the handicap entrance on the south side of the church by the restrooms. We will brick in the open area and place the handicap door in that wall opening up to the outside. There will not be a door that will open and close each time someone goes to the restroom from the main body of the church. You will be able to go through the enclosed hallway into the restrooms. The ramps are also being changed to accommodate the renovation.

### *Cycles of Faith – 21st Sunday in Ordinary Time*

In my travels I've visited cities like Washington, New York, and Chicago. And while I'm mostly a country person at heart, there is a certain vibrancy in city life. I like walking down the crowded streets of a shopping or entertainment district and watching the people. I suppose I enjoy it, because it is so different from the country road that I usually walk down in the early morning. If I'm taking an evening walk in the city, I'm always intrigued by the long lines that form outside certain clubs. You can hear the thumping of the music, and see the flashing of the lights. As I walk by, the waiting crowd is often trying to convince the bouncers guarding the doors that they know someone on the inside who would surely let them in if the person only knew they were out on the sidewalk. From my cursory observance, the pleading patrons are almost never admitted.

It is probably not fair to compare the kingdom of heaven to the big city club scene, even though people come from the east and the west, the north and the south, to get in on a Saturday night. Like the clubs, the kingdom of God does have an exclusive clientele, and you do have to know someone to get in - and He has to know you.

We get to know Jesus by spending time with Him through prayer and by reading the Bible. We get to know Him even better by our communion with Him when we receive the Eucharist. And we get to know Jesus when we discover Him in the hungry, the thirsty, the homeless, the stranger, the sick, and the imprisoned. There's not a line stretching around the corner to meet these kinds of people. But maybe there should be. If we want to get in to the best place ever, then we're going to have to line up to help these least ones.
