Readings: Gn 15:5-12, 17-18; Ps 27:1, 7-9, 13-14; Phil 3:17—4:1 or 3:20—4:1; Lk 9:28b-36

Abram's faith is sealed with a covenant initiated by God, our light and our salvation. The transfiguration of Jesus prefigures the transformation in glory to which we are called by our sharing in the paschal mystery—the dying and rising of Jesus.

February 28, 2016—Third Sunday of Lent

Readings: Ex 3:1-8a, 13-15; Ps 103:1-4, 6-8, 11; 1 Cor 10:1-6, 10-12; Lk 13:1-9

From the burning bush, Moses is called by God to lead his people out of slavery into freedom. The parable of the fig tree speaks, on the one hand, of God's patience, but, on the other, of the urgency of the call to conversion. Like the Hebrews of old, we too have failed to heed God's call, thinking ourselves to be self-righteous

PRO-LIFE CORNER

In the past year, the Texas legislature and Governor shut down multiple channels of funding to Planned Parenthood, totaling a whopping \$1.8 million.

Arkansas, Kansas, New Hampshire, North Carolina, Utah and Wisconsin have also nixed large amounts of their funding. Pro-life legislators in another six states are fighting to cut millions of dollars from the abortion giant.
