- Fr. Tommy's Corner -

The "Lord I am not worthy..." – In preparation for the reception of Holy Communion, of our Lord's true presence of His Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity, we echo the words of the Roman centurion who asked for Jesus to heal his paralyzed servant in the 8th chapter of St. Matthew's gospel. When our Lord agrees to go heal his servant, the centurion responds, "Lord, I am not worthy to have you enter under my roof; only say the word and my servant will be healed" (Matthew 8: 8). The Roman soldier doesn't feel worthy that Christ should go to his house, but instead he has faith that Jesus only needs to desire the healing of his servant and it would happen, even if it be from a distance. What a great faith this centurion has in Christ! We strive to reflect that same deep faith in Christ right before the moment of Holy Communion, when we ask Jesus to heal our souls from any spiritual illness of sin before He enters under the "roof" of our souls, for we are "temples" or "homes" for God. The new translation literally lifts the words from the centurion's mouth and places them in our mouths to ask Christ for spiritual healing, so that we may be made worthy to receive His most pure Body and His most

precious and life-giving Blood into our bodies and our souls: "Lord, I am not worthy that you should enter under my roof, but only say the word and my soul shall be healed."

Third Sunday of Easter – Journey tales (stories) are a



popular form of literature. Some involve a quest and others reflect a wandering experience. These stories have as a common thread the gradual unfolding of discovery as the journey progresses. New insights are gained and in many tales it is revealed that not everyone is as he or she first seems.

That is certainly the case in this Sunday's Gospel, which portrays the journey to Emmaus, a small village about seven miles northwest of Jerusalem. Jesus comes upon two disciples who are dismayed about the Crucifixion. He talks with them on the way and opens their minds to an understanding of the Scriptures. When they sit down together for the evening meal, they recognize Him in the breaking of the bread.

Whether the story is historically accurate or not is of little consequence. It is the meaning that is most important. The real presence of the risen Lord is revealed in the breaking of the bread. When Christians gather, whether around a table in Emmaus or an altar halfway around the world from that little town, the risen Lord is truly there. In the Eucharist we celebrate each Sunday, Christ is really present. Preachers are fond of asking the question, "What would you do if you met Jesus today?" as though Jesus were only present two thousand years ago. But the fact is that in the Eucharist we really do encounter Christ. We meet Him each time we celebrate Mass and receive Communion. So the preacher's question is far from idle speculation. As the Emmaus story points out clearly, we do meet Christ. But for all of us the question still remains: "What would you do?" Do you have an answer?
