the Gospel of Mark so that you will be better prepared to hear and understand the Sunday Gospels as they are proclaimed each week at Mass.

The beginning of Advent is Sunday, December 3, 2017. This marks the start of a new liturgical year (Cycle B) for the Catholic Church. Therefore, most of the Sunday Gospels will be from the Gospel According to Mark.

Mark's Gospel, regarded as the earliest Gospel, presents a stark and challenging portrait of Jesus' public ministry, which leads into a dramatic account of his passion and death. It has often been described as a passion narrative with a long introduction. For this reason, Mark's work is sometimes called the Gospel of Suffering. As we study and pray through this text, we will have to face the suffering of Jesus, the Son of God, and the suffering that is part of our lives as individuals and as citizens of the world.
