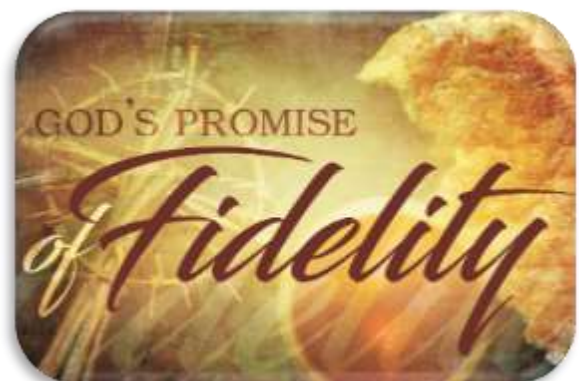

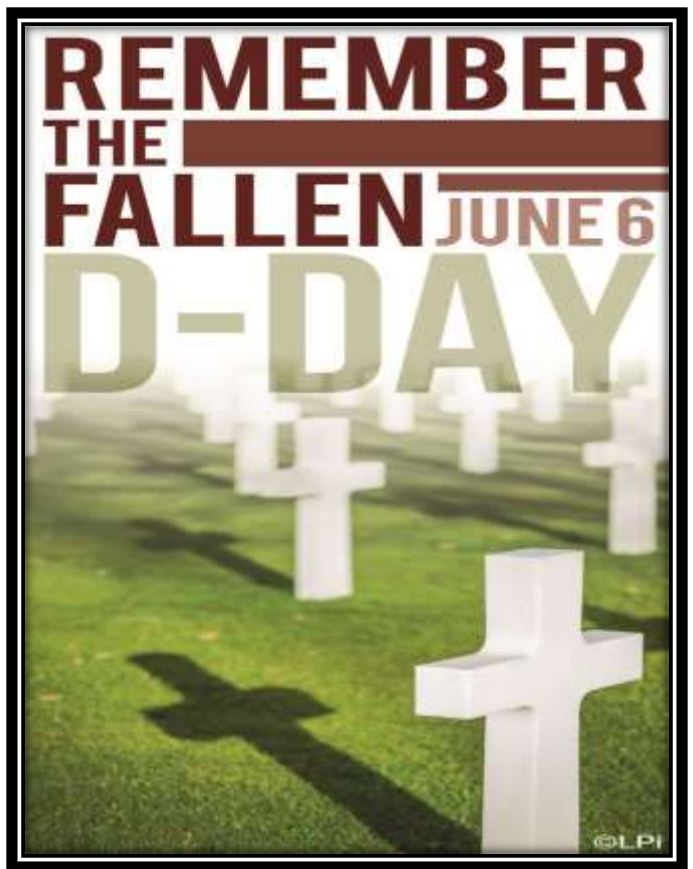
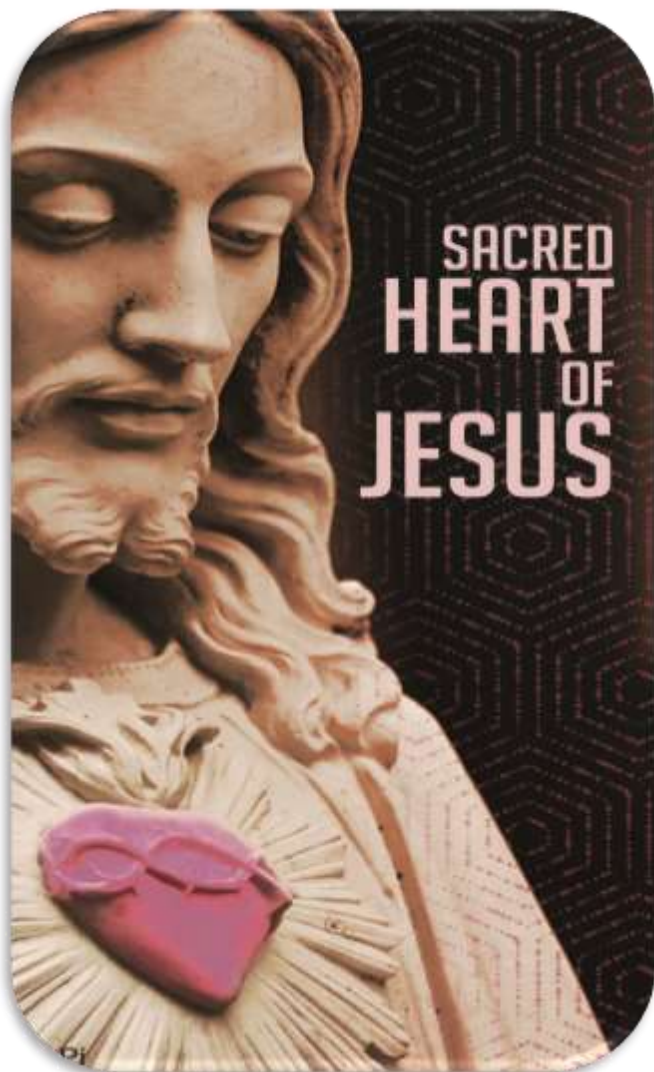
2018-2019 SACRED HEART CATHOLIC SCHOOL REGISTRATION NOW IN PROGRESS for Pre-K3 – 12
