During the Lenten Season, let's reflect upon the next Seven Last Words of Christ: (continued)

Sometimes cruelty and mercy, savagery and nobility, sin and virtue dwell side by side within us. 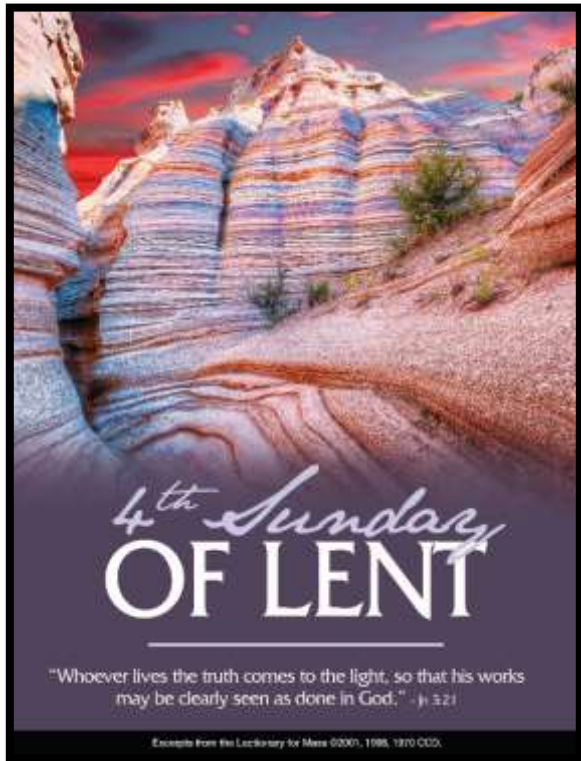
