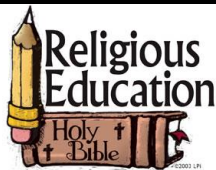

Please bring an appetizer, side dish, or dessert to share. If you are not a member, but would just like to find out more about the Christian Mothers, please join us for our next meeting!

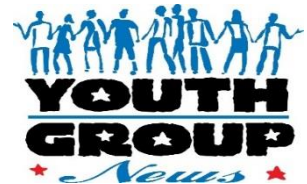
