Please check Facebook for updates. We are waiting a couple of weeks to see how the safety measures are working for public school. If there is not a big increase in Covid cases, our plans are to begin lessons September 16, 2020. Due to our limited space we will be using a family catechesis model. A calendar will be sent home with your families scheduled "in church & in class" lesson. This will be different and a challenge at first, but we know your family will greatly benefit from this opportunity. Each 4-5 weeks will be your turn to come together in church for instructions on how to teach the next 3-4 lessons. There are very simple directions included for families with children in multiple grades. I've tried it and it is very doable.
