If there is not a big increase in Covid cases, our plans are to begin lessons September 16, 2020. Due to our limited space we will be using a family catechesis model. A calendar will be sent home with your families scheduled "in church & in class" lesson. This will be different and a challenge at first, but we know your family will greatly benefit from this opportunity.
