Today is "Gaudete" Sunday—Latin for "Rejoice." We are celebrating the Third Sunday of Advent as we draw closer to Christmas. Let us use these last two weeks of Advent to really reflect upon what this season is all about. Let us pray for all who have died recently and all who are seriously ill. Let us pray for them and their families as we continue our Advent Journey to Christmas.

We thank Harvey Jahn for making and providing our unique Advent Wreath in the Foyer of the Church. It has the traditional four candles of Advent on the wreath and the Christmas candle in the middle. It also has six candles between each of the four candles to remind us of each of the days of Advent during that week. It is said that the person who came up with the idea of the extra candles thought it would help the children realize how much closer we are to Christmas Day as we light each candle of the week.
