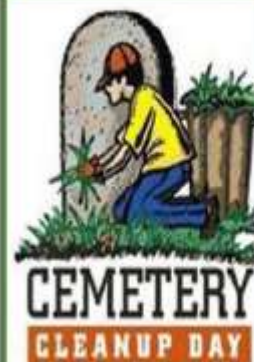

Bottom Line: When you follow Jesus, you discover a life better than the 'normal' life lived before.
