We have some special feasts coming up soon. Please reflect upon these saints.

Tuesday, September 29, is the Feast of Saints Michael, Gabriel and Rafael, Archangels. These biblical messengers signify God's transcendence and loving care: Michael (meaning "Who is like God?"), Gabriel ("God's Strength") and Raphael ("God's Remedy"); Michael: patron of security forces and of the sick; Gabriel: of telecommunications and the postal service; Raphael: of travelers and the blind.

Thursday, October 1, is the Feast of Therese of the Child Jesus. Therese Martin, the Little Flower, died September 30, 1897, of tuberculosis in the Carmel of Lisieux at age twenty-four. She was proclaimed a doctor of the Church by St. Pope John Paul II, October 19, 1997. She is patroness of the missions, of florists, and of France.

Friday, October 2, is the Feast of the Holy Guardian Angels. We are told that the Lord is ever with us. His ways are beyond our understanding. Even the lowliest among us is precious in God's sight.

Sunday, October 4, is the Feast of St. Francis of Assisi. He is known for his love for and care of animals.

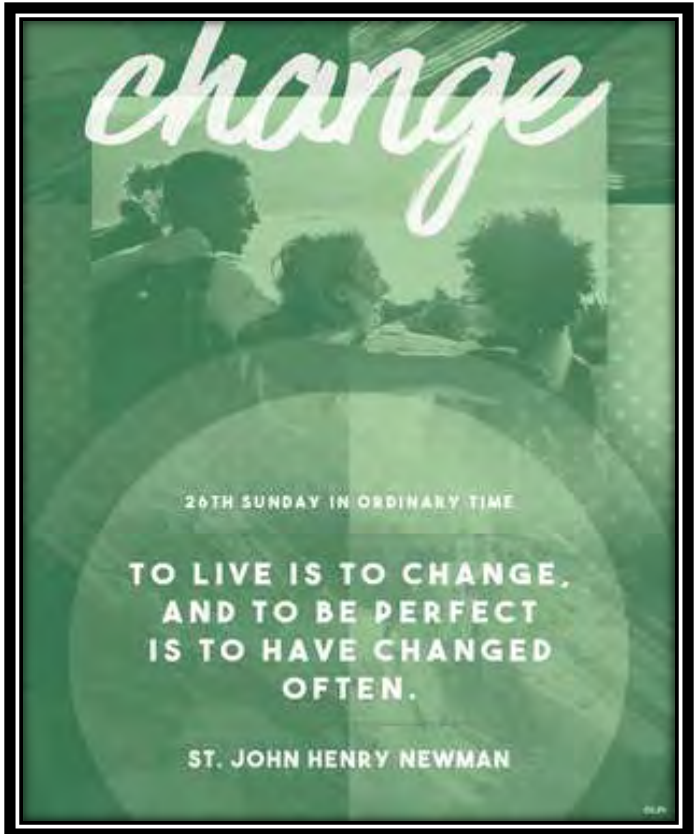

Bring your whole family! Children are a sign of life! Bring your lawn chairs, umbrellas, and strollers.

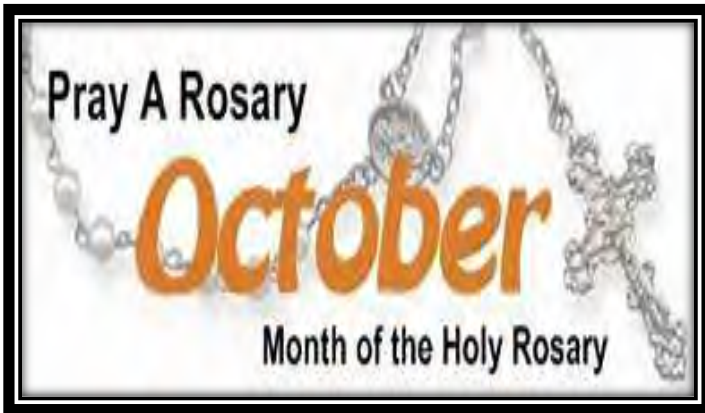

**GOSPEL MEDITATION - ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE
 26th Sunday in Ordinary Time**

What prompts you to make the decisions you make? When confronted with a decision, whether one that is more trivial and mundane or one that is more significant and profound, we rely on guidance. That guidance can be the result of impulse and passion or the fruit of the interior voice of conscience. Decisions made on impulse and passion can be misguided and erroneous. Decisions based on conscience, or the moral voice within, will reflect the depth and maturity of our soul work. A more contemplative soul will make more contemplative decisions. A less developed conscience will make decisions based on the individual's level of development.

Conversion and a change of heart are at the core of Jesus' message precisely because of this reality. We are works in progress. For the person on fire with the Holy Spirit and centered on God, life reflects an ever-deepening awareness and heightened sense of God's presence and a greater willingness to do God's will. What is happening internally is validated by what is witnessed externally. The hypocrite is the one who says yes when they really mean no. From the start, they had no desire to do the virtuous act but wanted to outwardly appear as if they did.

Where are you on the road of integrity? Honesty is all that is required. God is good with that. It is okay to struggle with our decisions and wrestle with ourselves. Consciences on the path to maturity and greater depth are not always going to know what action is immediately best. We may, at first, say no to what we know is right and, after prayerful reflection and thought, come around to doing it. Conversion happens when our no changes to yes, regardless of how sinful or out of sync we may be at the time. God is anxious to welcome us to Himself. But we cannot embrace Him unless we want to. Learning to orient our gift of free will to what is of divine origin, right, and best is a discipline we must always tweak and perfect.

All Pastors in the Victoria Diocese received this letter from Bishop Cahill this week.

Office of the Bishop

September 23, 2020

Dear Pastors,

Last week I informed our faithful that the dispensation from the obligation to participate in the liturgy on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation is not being extended beyond September 30. As we anticipate the participation of more of the faithful in the Sunday Eucharist in the coming months I realize it is time to update the guidelines that I published on April 27. Based on conversations with some doctors and local health officials in Victoria and the other counties in our area, I am focusing on four areas to ensure our safe and joyful return to the Sunday Eucharist.

Masks - Parishioners must be strongly encouraged to wear masks during the Sunday worship. Priests and Eucharistic Ministers must wear masks during the distribution of communion.

I realize this has become a political issue and believe the Governor is correct in his approach not to issue a mandate, but instead to offer strong encouragement. I will support a Pastor if the Pastor decides in his particular Church or at particular Masses people must wear masks.

Social Distancing -The Church must be arranged in such a way that people aren't breathing on each other.

I think the easiest set-up has been every other row, with a family on each end of the row. Some larger Churches have scheduled over-flow space in the gym or auditorium, some other Churches have added a Mass time on Saturday and/or Sunday to accommodate.

Handwashing/Sanitization - Priests, Deacons and Ministers must practice good hand hygiene, and the Church must be cleaned after every Mass.

I think the parishes have established pretty good protocols on cleaning before and after every Mass. I know some have been concerned about possible damage to pews and there has been some good discussion about how to care for the furniture and keep the pews sanitized.

Holy Water - Holy Water fonts must remain empty.

This was a surprise to me, I thought it would be all right to re-fill the Holy Water fonts. It became clear to me that each medical person had serious concerns about the possible spread of germs through multiple people touching the same source. Some Pastors have encouraged people to bring their own Holy Water bottles and fill them at the Church, others have used the Sprinkling Rite at some of the Masses.

God bless you all in your blessed ministry of leading the People of God every day-you are an example of shepherds who "smell of the sheep", walking the road with strength, courage and hope! Let's keep each other in prayer,
