From the Desk of Msgr. John

Wearing Masks—It is important not only to wear a mask, but to wear it properly. To be effective, a mask must cover **the mouth and the nose**. Many people leave the nose uncovered. **PLEASE** try to wear your mask properly for your sake and for the sake of others.

Due to the coronavirus pandemic, we continue to institute various modifications, regarding the celebration of the Sacraments and sacramentals, which includes the upcoming Memorial of St. Blaise and Ash Wednesday.

The particular paragraph in the Book of Blessings (Cf. No. 1628) permits the celebrant, when warranted for pastoral reasons, to impart the blessing of throats by extending his hands over the liturgical assembly, while reciting the prayer of blessing only once. This is the manner in which throats will be blessed in this year of 2021, in the Diocese of Victoria. We will do this, this weekend of January 30 and 31 and again on Wednesday, February 3, 2021.

Regarding Ash Wednesday. The Holy See published a directive (cf. Prot. N. 17/21), that ashes will be imposed by sprinkling. The celebrant blesses the ashes in the manner set forth in the Roman Missal, and imposes them by sprinkling a small portion of the ashes on the crown of each person's head, without the use of any type of words or wording.

In light of the directive cited above, ashes will be distributed this year, in the Diocese of Victoria, by sprinkling a small amount of ashes on the crown of each person's head, without any words or wording, and **NOT** imposed on the forehead of the faithful.

We do so to continue to provide protection to both clergy and laity alike, in the midst of this pandemic
