Sacred Heart Parish presents a teaching and exposition of Sacred Relics on **Sunday December 11, at 2:00 pm. at Sacred Heart Catholic Church.** The relics will be set up on tables in the **Sacred Heart Gym** after Father Martin's talk in Church. The exposition will run from 3:00 p.m. until ?. Father Carlos Martins, of the Companions of the Cross, will be here with his very special ministry to teach about these holy objects. He will bring with him over 150 relics, some as old as 2000 years. Among the treasures will be relics of St. Maria Goretti, St. Therese of Lisieux (the "Little Flower"), St. Francis of Assisi, St. Anthony of Padua, St. Thomas Aquinas, and St. Faustina Kowalska. In addition, there will also be present a portion of the veil of Our Lady, as well as one of the largest remaining pieces of the True Cross in the world. Those in attendance will be able to examine and venerate each relic. In the Church's history many miracles and healings have been worked in the presence of relics, and many have been healed through this ministry. Please do not miss this opportunity. You are encouraged to bring your articles of devotion (such as rosaries, holy cards, etc.) and pictures of ill friends/family members which you will be able to touch to the reliquaries as a means of intercession.

December 12—Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe

As suggested: A woman, clothed with the sun, daughter of the Most High God, proclaims the greatness of the Lord, the One who comes to dwell with us. She is the servant of the Lord.

Today's feast recalls the apparitions of Mary at the hill of Tepeyac from 9-12 December 1531 to the native convert, St. Juan Diego (9 Dec.); known to the Aztecs as *Tecoatlaxope* (or *de Guadalupe* in Spanish), meaning "she will crush the serpent of stone"; declared Patroness of the Americas by Pope Pius XII.
