With the First Sunday of Advent, we begin a new Church Year. The Church Year goes from the First Sunday of Advent until the Saturday after Christ the King.

During Advent, we have the Feast of the Immaculate Conception of Mary on December 8th. This is a Holy Day of Obligation. We celebrate the Immaculate Conception of Mary in the womb of her mother, St. Ann.

We also celebrate the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe on December 12th. We will have a special Mass in English and Spanish with the Spanish Choir on Tuesday, December 12th, at 6:00 p.m. at Sacred Heart Catholic Church, followed by a meal in the Family Center. You may bring something, such as snacks or a side dish, if you wish. If you have not been to a Mass celebrating Our Lady of Guadalupe, it would be well worth your time to attend.


