From the Desk of Msgr. John

Today we celebrate the Feast of Pentecost, the Birthday of the Church. This brings our Easter Season to a close. We now begin Ordinary Time in the Church Year.

Our Parish picnics are coming up soon—St. John, July 4th and Moravia, July 18th. We ask everyone’s full cooperation and support as usual.

On May 13, Pope Francis was in Fatima, celebrating Mass for the 100th Anniversary of the first appearance of Mary to the young shepherd children. As part of the celebration of this anniversary, Pope Francis has offered the following opportunity for a special plenary indulgence: “The faithful, with devotion, can visit a statue of Our Lady of Fatima solemnly exposed for public veneration in any church, oratory, or proper place of prayer during the days of the anniversary of the apparitions, the 13th of each month from May to October 2017, and there devoutly participate in some celebration or prayer in honor of the Virgin Mary. In addition, the faithful must pray the Our Father, recite the Creed and invoke Our Lady of Fatima. The faithful who, because of age, illness or other serious causes, may pray in front of a statue of Our Lady of Fatima and must spiritually unite themselves to the jubilee celebrations on the days of the apparitions, the 13th of each month, between May and October 2017. They must also “offer to merciful God with confidence, through Mary, their prayers and sufferings or the sacrifices they make in their own lives.” In addition to the above, those seeking to obtain the indulgence must receive Holy Communion, go to Confession, be interiorly detached from sin, and pray for the intentions of the Holy Father.

On Tuesday, June 13th at Sacred Heart Church, Hallettsville, a statue of Our Lady of Fatima will be available for veneration for all the faithful throughout the day.

Then, Tuesday evening, at 7:00 p.m. in honor of the Blessed Virgin Mary, a special time of prayer and veneration will be held. All are invited! Bring your children and grandchildren!

PRO-LIFE CORNER—

Some 86 cosponsors in the 115th Congress are supporting the Life at Conception Act, in the Senate (S.231) and in the House (H.R. 681)

The key to a Life at Conception Act lies within the Supreme Court's ruling itself. Many do not realize that the Supreme Court did not permanently legalize abortion in its 1973 Roe vs. Wade decision.

The High Court instead stated that it did not know when life began. It admitted that if personhood is established, the appellant's case collapse, for the fetus' right to life is then guaranteed specifically by the 14th Amendment.

The 14th Amendment clearly states that no state shall “deprive any person of life, liberty or property, without due process of law, or deny to any person within its jurisdiction the equal protection of the law.”

And Section 5 of the 14th Amendment to the Constitution specifically assigns to Congress the responsibility of defining and protecting personhood by legislation.
