PRO-LIFE CORNER—

When it comes to the religious education of our own children, what particularly matters, in addition to teaching basics, is the example we give by our lives, how we trust in God. Children find it much easier to develop in their own relationship with God when they have witnessed both their mother and father really taking their Faith seriously.

At any rate, it seems to me a somewhat unreasonable burden on the mother when, not infrequently, in addition to the double burden of work and family, the task of the religious education of the children also falls on her. It is essential that this joint responsibility should be jointly borne. Again and again, one sees how difficult, how almost impossible it is for Catholic mothers to keep their children open to the Faith beyond puberty, if the fathers do not also see after God.

May the recent (August 2018) World Meeting of Families in Ireland bring new inspiration to religious life within the family.
