National Life Chain, Sunday, 2018, a peaceful and prayerful Pro-Life witness, will be held on sidewalks and roadways throughout the U.S. and Canada on Sunday afternoon, October 7. Last year 1,548 cities and towns joined the annual event, which began in two small California towns in 1987. Participants nationwide gather to take a public stand and pray to end abortion while holding signs with messages such as, "Abortion Kills Children", "Abortion Hurts Women", "Adoption, the Loving Option," and "Jesus Forgives and Heals."
