June 27: Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Readings: Wis 1:13-15; 2:23-24; Ps 30:2-4, j-6, 11-13; 2 Cor 8:7, 9, 13-15; Mk 5:21-43; or 5:21-24, 35b-43

Because of sin, sickness and death have entered the world, but are overcome through the resurrection of Jesus. He hears the cry of those in need, healing the sick and raising the dead to life. He made himself poor that we might become rich.

July 4: Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Readings: EZ 2:2-5; Ps 123:1-; 2 Cor 12:7-10; Mk 6:1-6a

Jesus is met with misgivings and rejection by his own relations. Like them, we often resist the prophetic word because of an obstinacy of heart, rooted in a self-pride which must give way to weakness and powerlessness.

July 11: Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Readings: Am 7:12-15; Ps 85:9-14; Eph 1:3-14 or 1:3-10, Mk 6:7-13

The prophet hears what God proclaims and is called to speak in God's name. The Twelve hear the message of Jesus and are sent forth to preach the good news. In him have we been chosen to be full of love.
