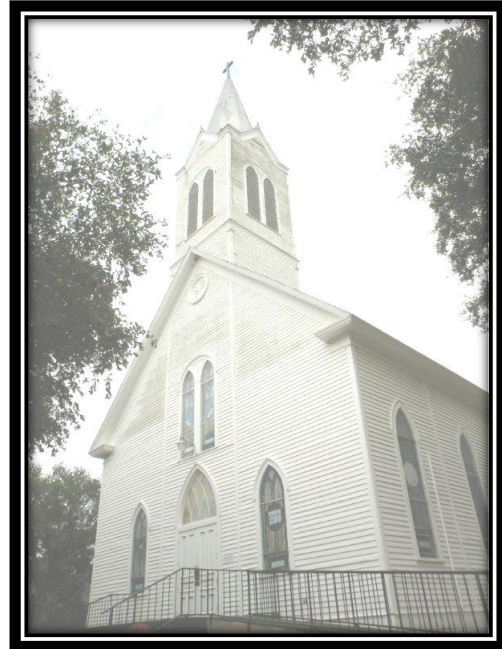

Participants nationwide gather to take a public stand and pray to end abortion while holding signs with messages such as, "Abortion Kills Children", "Abortion Hurts Women", "Adoption, the Loving Option," and "Jesus Forgives and Heals."

Each year in the Fall and the Spring, Bishop Cahill has a convocation with all the priests of the Diocese of Victoria. It is a time to hear, from the Bishop, to celebrate Mass together and to study and reflect on the Priesthood. Father Max and I attended Sunday evening until Tuesday evening recently along with the other priests of the Diocese. It was a very enlightening and spiritual experience.

Our Diocesan Services Appeal (DSA) report has come in from the Chancery. The DSA is our way of helping support the works of Bishop Cahill and the Diocese of Victoria. Each parish is assessed a percentage of its Sunday Collections (only weekly collections—not picnic income or other types of donations). This past year of DSA for St. Mary is broken down as follows:
